QUALIFICATIONS

- Standard High School or High School Equivalency Diploma
- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Must be 21 years of age (or 19 years and 6 months by date of written test)
- 35 or older not eligible- up to 7yrs active duty may be deducted from age.
- Must pass the Cooper Physical Fitness Test, Medical, Psychological, and background investigation.
